HIGHLIGHTING OUR MISSIONS GIVING

A few weeks ago, the Togo FMC held their annual convention in the village of Klokpe. The theme of the convention, "Your Testimony Impacting the World," was designed to encourage the members to share their testimony-in word and deed, so that others may be transformed. A living example was right there with us. Our Togo leader, Dosseh, knew Jean from Lome. Jean relocated to Asiama and when the FMC began a church plant there, Pastor Yaovi went looking for Jean. He found him and his family. Jean's wife and mother began coming to church. After a while, all of a sudden, Jean refused to let them continue going to church. In fact, when Yaovi visited their home, Jean chased Yaovi away! Well, Sometimes these things happen. Yaovi proceeded with the work. He prepared people for baptism and invited Dosseh, as his leader to be there for the baptism. To Dosseh's surprise, when he arrived, there was Jean! When asked what was happening he just smiled and said he wanted to be baptized. He was and the whole family has continued. Last Sunday Jean and his wife were at the Togo South convention. They had to board transport and travel a good hour to there. You can take that as a sign of commitment and the real work of the Spirit in Jean.

Her resignation is effective March 31, 2019 after almost 11 years in that role. Dr. Delia and her husband Paul will continue as part of the FMWM team for Latin America full time at least through the end of 2019.
