HIGHLIGHTING OUR MISSIONS GIVING

Vickie Reynen is the ICCM coordinator for Africa and she writes to us: Our biennial ICCM Africa Learning Conference took place in Rwanda this year, with ICCM National Coordinators and staff from nine African countries participating. Vickie and her colleague, Mrs. Neddy Dingili planned the event with the invaluable help of our Rwandan hosts. This conference is always a time to review best practices for an effective, impactful ICCM program in each country, as well as a time for fun and fellowship. Our African team had several new additions since the last conference, so it was especially good to have them be a part of this great event. A multitude of thanks to ICCM Director, Dr. Linda Adams, for her commitment to developing our national ICCM staff! More on ICCM next week...

OTHER MISSION NEWS

AFRICA-Pray for missionaries Thom and Sherry Cahill who will be traveling throughout the east coast for partnership building. Their goal is to return to Tanzania in January. Pray for strong partnerships to be established. In addition to needed financial support, they have a goal of 300 prayer partners who will commit to pray for Africa daily.

ASIA-Pray for the Free Methodist Church in Japan. During recent meetings with the Asia Area Director, the leadership in Japan indicated a desire to strengthen our partnership with them. Gene and Minori Hall will join the Wilkins and the Veronese families in Tokyo later in July after General Conference. Pray for Abraham, the country leader in Creative Access Country-N. Abraham and his family have been asked by the landowner to vacate their property, and there are currently no viable options for them to consider. This move will displace his family, a significant church, and ministry to children. Pray for resources to rent a much better facility.

EUROPE-Al and Diane Mellinger (missionaries to Bulgaria) invite you to pray for preparations being made to launch new church plants in three countries in the Balkan region this fall. Pray for the selection of church planters and target cities, and the connection with persons open to the gospel in each town. Praise the Lord for Phil and Debra Gilmore newly appointed missionaries to Spain. They will serve a two-year assignment in Spain beginning in January 2020. Phil will help develop a training center for the Impact Europe church-planting network. Debra will help provide leadership at the Mosaic Cultural Center in Madrid. Pray for them as they enter a period of partnership building.

LATIN AMERICA-This past weekend, Pastor John Jairo Leal (CCP Coordinator for Latin America), Dr. Glenn Lorenz (FMWM Missionary) and Dr. Casto Rojas (Superintendent for Creative Access Country-X) led a Community Church Planting Implementation seminar in Lima, Peru. The 39 people in attendance represented most of the FM churches in Peru. They increased their understanding of the CCP process and strengthened the unity between churches. Please pray that this training will bear much fruit for the kingdom of God and result in new churches throughout the country.
