**OTHER MISSION NEWS**

**AFRICA**-Praise the Lord for those who served with relief efforts in Mozambique. Pastor Hendrik Smidderks reports that repairs were made to the Beira church, the Manga church, and the Matakaune church buildings as well as the parsonages. Medical personnel treated 665 patients at a clinic in Beira. Another team, including medical personnel, traveled to the Nhaloi Hospital, where they worked alongside the hospital staff and local church to make repairs to the hospital and assist in medical clinics. Continue to pray for Mozambique and ongoing recovery efforts after the cyclone that hit earlier this year.

**ASIA**- Free Methodist leaders from Asia are making preparations to attend the U.S. General Conference in July. Pray for visas that are yet to be obtained, for funding and for the necessary travel arrangements. Praise the Lord for newly baptized believers in Myanmar, Creative Access Country-VN, and Creative Access Country- BG. Pray for the ongoing discipleship of these new believers.

**EUROPE**-Praise the Lord! The Anderson family received their Hungarian residency permits last week after only two tries. Continue to pray for Chadwick, Sarah and their four daughters as they get settled and adapt to living in Hungary.

Raouf Soliman is an Egyptian missionary based in Madrid, Spain. He serves on the pastoral team of Kanisa, an Arabic-language fellowship in Madrid. He has also been working with the Free Methodist Church across Europe to reach Arabic-speaking people with the gospel of Christ. Please pray for the immediate financial needs of his ministry and his effectiveness in reaching Arab people, many who are refugees.

**LATIN AMERICA**-Urgent Prayer Needed Bishop Desvariste shares that the political situation in Haiti has worsened. There are demonstrations and violence in many parts of the country. Please pray for the people of Haiti and the Free Methodist Church there. Pray for the Holy Spirit to move, bringing peace and stability to the country. Pray for wisdom for church leaders as they seek to support church members with food and other necessities.
